Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format.
Cut out the squares and the rectangle.

Small Red Kit: Mitters $\downarrow$

From the squares fold mittens, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 1719. The height of the finished mitten will be $1 / 2$ of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches ( 4 cm ).


SRRaI Red Lsig: From this rectangle fold the hat, according the diagrams, presented Hat in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 2022. The width of the finished hat will be $1 / 3$ of the long side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about $21 / 4$ inches $(5.8 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## Small Red Kit: Scapf $\rightarrow$

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the rectangle.

Fold the scarf, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 19-20. The width of the finished scarf will be $1 / 3$ of the short side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about 1 1/4 inches ( 3 cm ).

## Medimme <br> Red Kit: Mitters

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the squares.

Fold mittens, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 17-19. The height of the finished mitten will be $1 / 2$ of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about 2 3/4 inches ( 6.5 cm ).

## Medionme

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the rectangle.

Fold the hat, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 20-22. The width of the finished hat will be $1 / 3$ of the long side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about 3 1/2 inches ( 8.5 cm ).


## Small Blue Kit: Mitters, Mat E Scapf

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the squares and the rectangle.

Sraall Blue Leif: From the squares fold mittens, according the diagrams, presented Mitters in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 1719. The height of the finished mitten will be $1 / 2$ of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches ( 4 cm ).


Sraal Blye Laif: From this rectangle fold the hat, according the diagrams, presented Hab in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 2022. The width of the finished hat will be $1 / 3$ of the long side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about $21 / 4$ inches ( 5.8 cm ).

## Srall BIue Kit: Scapf $\rightarrow$

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the rectangle.

Fold the scarf, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 19-20. The width of the finished scarf will be $1 / 3$ of the short side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about $11 / 4$ inches ( 3 cm ).

## Medionm Blue Kit: Mitters

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format. Cut out the squares.

Fold mittens, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 17-19. The height of the finished mitten will be $1 / 2$ of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about 2 3/4 inches ( 6.5 cm ).
